[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.08.2018 in CWP No.7775 of 2014 in case titled as Roop Lal and another vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7775 of 2014 was allowed and the petitioners held entitled to the pay/emoluments of the post of Junior Engineers (Civil) for the period they had held the additional charge of such higher post. The respondent was directed to calculate the requisite benefits and release the same to the petitioners within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, at the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that benefits as per entitlement have been calculated and released to the petitioners, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
