[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.08.2018 in CWP No.7716 of 2014 in case titled as Thuru Ram vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7716 of 2014 was allowed and the petitioner held entitled to the pay/emoluments of the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) for the period that he had held the additional charge of such higher post. The respondent was directed to calculate the requisite benefits and release the same to the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that benefit as per entitlement has been calculated and released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
