Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners, who are the Guest Teachers, have been transferred and they have not been given the station, which has been opted by them despite the fact that they were having higher marks than the private respondents No. 8 and 9, who have been given the District, which was opted by the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case the Guest Teachers are to be transferred, the candidate having higher marks is to be allotted the station opted by him in preference to the candidate having lower merit, failing which the same will be violation of the transfer policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representations dated 12.12.2022 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) but the same are still pending

consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at

this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representations dated 09.12.2022 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representations, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representations dated 09.12.2022 (Annexures P-8 and P-9), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
