Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 & 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation into the complaint (Annexure P-1), submitted by the petitioner.

The said complaint is against the private respondents No.4 to 6, who alleged to have committed the offence of cheating and fraud with the petitioner, as a result of which, the hard earned money of the father of the petitioner as well as the original passport of the petitioner is in the illegal possession of the private respondents No.4 to 6.

A perusal of the status report (Annexure P-2), which was filed before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, shows that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda marked the complaint of the petitioner, vide his office No.296/Canal Colony/22, dated 11.04.2022, to the Incharge, E.O., Wing, Bathinda. It was also stated in the status report that enquiry in the complaint is being conducted by the E.O., Wing, Bathinda.

Para 8 of the said status report further depicts that report was prepared for registration of case against Amarjit Singh and Laddi Sandhu, which was sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police. The matter is still pending with the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, as has been alleged by the petitioner in the present petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
