Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that prior to joining respondent No. 3-Institute, the petitioner had already applied for the post of Assistant Professor (Radiation Oncology) but the prayer of the petitioner for the grant of 'No Objection Certificate' to compete for the said post is being kept pending by the respondents, which is causing prejudice. The prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents be directed to take appropriate decision on the prayer of the petitioner to issue 'No Objection Certificate' so as to allow the petitioner to compete for the post of Assistant Professor (Radiation Oncology), which has been advertised by respondent No. 1.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Balwinder Sangwan, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No. 4-HPSC.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in case, the request of the petitioner for the grant of 'No Objection Certificate' has not been decided up to today, the said prayer will be decided in accordance with law within a period of 7 days from today by passing an appropriate speaking order and the same will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
