Civil Appeal No.330/2020 titled as “*Surinder Kaur vs Inderjit Singh Bawa*”; Civil Appeal No.256/2020, titled as “*Inderjit Singh Bawa vs Surinder Kaur*” and Civil Appeal No.255/2020, titled as “*Inderjit Singh Bawa vs Surinder Kaur*” are pending in the Court of Shri Manoj Kumar, Additional District Judge, Ludhiana. An application was moved by applicant-Surinder Kaur to transfer all the three appeals in some other Court as the respondents were openly proclaiming that they had approached the Court and so applicant had apprehension that adverse order shall be passed against her. Said transfer application has been dismissed by learned District Judge, Ludhiana, vide impugned order dated 15.12.2022, against which this revision is filed.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I find absolutely no merit in the revision.

A perusal of the impugned order reveals that learned District Judge, Ludhiana, even called for the comments of the learned Presiding Officer, who denied the allegations. It was noticed further that earlier

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also, Shri Vijay Kumar, learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, had made a reference to transfer the appeals as the applicant had created hue and cry in the Court. It was also noticed that applicant was in the habit of levelling false allegations against the Presiding Officer. Learned District Judge, rightly noticed that in order to transfer a case, there must exist something more compelling from the point of public justice and not the attitude of a sensitive litigant. Except for expressing apprehension that applicant may not get justice, no substantive reason was given for transfer. Transfer cannot be made on such vague allegation, which has not been supported by any relevant material.

As such, impugned order is maintained. Finding no perversity or illegality therein, present revision is dismissed.
