1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.02.2019 in CWP No.89 of 2018.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that payments as per entitlement determined vide Annexure P-1 have been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

4. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
