This revision petition has been filed by late Sh. Karamjeet Singh through his legal representatives. A decree for recovery of the money has been passed against late Sh. Karamjeet Singh and his daughter. During the pendency of the suit, Sh. Karamjeet Singh died.

The petitioner claims exemption from attachment and consequent sale of the property in terms of Section 60(1)(ccc) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. It is evident that the petitioner never objected to the execution of the decree on this ground before the Executing Court. He has assailed the correctness of the order by which the Executing Court has published the schedule of the judgment debtor's property. The petitioner, if, so advised may file appropriate objections before the Executing Court.

At this stage, no ground to exercise jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is made out.

With all these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
