The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure that petitioner, his wife and son are not implicated in a false criminal matter at the behest of respondent Nos.5 to 9 and further to decided representation dated 19.11.2019 (Annexure P-6) submitted by petitioner to respondent No.3 - the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he has instructions to state that during pendency of the present writ petition, the matter has been amicable resolved amongst the parties and there is no surviving cause of action left for adjudication in the present petition.

The present petition is accordingly disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
