Through this petition, the petitioner seeks interim regular bail in case bearing FIR No.46 dated 14.07.2021, registered at Police Station Aur, District SBS Nagar, under Section 22 NDPS Act, enabling her to attend the 'Bhog Ceremony', of her grand-mother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the grand-mother of the petitioner passed away on 13.12.2022; that due to her confinement in jail, the petitioner could not attend the funeral rites of her grand-mother, and that now the 'Bhog Ceremony' of her grand-mother is to be held on 23.12.2022 at village Gurpar, as would decipher from the Card (Annexure P-5).

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the case of prosecution, 15 intoxicating injection alongwith 15 injection of Avil, were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

The petitioner seeks interim bail for attending the 'Bhog Ceremony' of her grand-mother. In the opinion of this Court, her presence

is not much necessary at the time of said ceremony. Moreover, there are other family members, who can perform the ceremony, if any.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
