ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Through the present petition, the petitioner is seeking quashing of the FIR on the grounds that the entire amount which was alleged against him, has been paid to the complainant pursuant to the statement made by counsel vide order dated 11.07.2022 passed in a bail petition i.e. CRM-M-20571-2022 titled as Randhir Singh vs. State of Punjab.

Since it would be appropriate for the petitioner to file a petition for quashing based on compromise but not on merits because the other accused did not pay back the money, as such the complainant is not willing to compromise the entire matter.

In the entirety of facts and circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition with liberty to file an application before the concerned Mediation Centre, Distt. Roop Nagar for mediation of his matter. In case, such application is filed, the Incharge of the Mediation Centre shall appoint a mediator and he/she will mediate the matter and peruse the all stake holder for compromise. In case, the mediation became successful and the compromise took place between them, it shall be permissible for them to file a quashing petition based on the compromise.

Petition is disposed of in the terms mentioned above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of. Registry to communicate this order to the Incharge of Mediation Centre of Roop Nagar.
