The petitioner through instant petition is seeking direction to transfer the investigation of FIR No.0042 dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 (Section 120-B of IPC added later on) at Police Station Navi Bardari, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that brother of petitioner in 2022 has committed alleged offence who was disowned by family on 05.09.2003 and for this purpose proper publication was made. The jurisdictional DSP is helping complainant. The petitioner had never met the complainant.
