Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for posting at Jhajjar keeping in view her merit in the selection, which benefit has not been extended to the petitioner and now the respondents have already undertaken before this Court in CWP No. 14553 of 2021 titled as ***Sandeep Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and another***, decided on 02.06.2022 that the respondents are already undertaking the process of allotment of station on the basis of the merit obtained by a candidate. Hence, the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner as well in terms of the said undertaking given before this Court in ***Sandeep Kumar's case (supra)***.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any grievance is raised by the petitioner to be covered by the undertaking given in ***Sandeep Kumar's case (supra)***, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such grievance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
