Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0117 dated 15.9.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, Shambhu, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 6.12.2019 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 6.12.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has, however, opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that petitioner is no more required

for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 6.12.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
