Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.141 dated 08.10.2019, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that petitioner No.1 had taken a sum of ₹11,00,000/- to send the son of the complainant abroad. It is also mentioned in the FIR that a sum of ₹4,90,000/- had been returned, but the rest of the amount is still to be returned. He also contends that the FIR does not mention the date, month and year in which the money had been paid. He also contends that petitioner No. 1 is a 27 year old lady while petitioner No. 2 is her mother. He also contends that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 18.12.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Narinder, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 18.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
