**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

Today, at the very outset, learned counsel submits that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to have recourse to appropriate remedy to approach the Family Court concerned as regards the custody of petitioner's minor child.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioner moves an appropriate application seeking custody of her minor child before the Family Court in accordance with law and some application for grant of interim relief is also moved therein, the Family Court concerned shall ensure that the said application is disposed of in the shortest possible time having due regard to the welfare of the minor child preferably within 3 weeks of filing of such application subject to the condition that respondent No.4 (husband of the petitioner) is served.

The petitioner would be at liberty to serve respondent No.4 through the counsel representing him in any other legal proceedings.
