This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct an enquiry in fair and impartial manner against respondents No.5 to 8 as they in connivance with each other embezzled the huge amount of their Forest Department being employee of the Forest Department and caused loss to the Government Exchequer by committing cheating and fraud and to direct respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, to consider and decide the representation dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim

of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
