Prayer in these petitions is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 175 dated 25.07.2019, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, Amritsar.

On 13.03.2020, petitioner Mohammad Mohsin @ MD Mohsin was granted the concession of interim bail in order to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement. Similarly, petitioner Shekhar Sharma was also granted interim bail on 10.06.2020.

As per custody certificates filed today in Court, petitioner Mohammad Mohsin @ MD Mohsin has undergone the custody of 07 months and 20 days, whereas petitioner Shekhar Sharma has undergone the custody of 10 months and 14 days.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that petitioner Mohammad Mohsin @ MD Mohsin has already paid 50% of the agreed amount to the complainant and the remaining amount will be paid by him at the time of recording of the statement of the parties before the trial Court in support of the compromise entered into between them.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection if the interim bail granted to the petitioners is confirmed with a condition that they will abide by the terms and conditions of the compromise and petitioner Mohammad Mohsin @ MD Mohsin will make the payment of balance amount at the time of recording of statement before the trial Court.

In view of the above, these petitions are disposed of. Interim bail granted to both the petitioners are confirmed.

However, it is made clear that the parties will remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.

Liberty is granted to the complainant to revive these petitions, if so required.

Let a photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.
