The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus by directing the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and the family members of petitioner No.1 at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

Affidavit of Ram Rattan Inspector SHO PS Industrial Area, Phase-1, Chandigarh has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record. The relevant extract thereof is reproduced herein after below:

“That in this regard it is submitted that the statement of both the petitioners was got recorded in which they stated that they were having relationship for last 08 years and they want to marry. In starting parents of petitioner Kiran were not agreeing for this, but now they have agreed and they both got engaged with the wishes of their parents.

They further stated that now they don't have any danger from anyone and they do not want any action on anybody. In the future, the petitioners will contact the police if any help will be required to them. As per the statement of petitioners now they don't have any danger/threat from anyone.”

A perusal of the said affidavit shows that both the petitioners have got their statements and that even their parents have conceded to their wish and do not cause any further danger.

In view of the aforesaid status report filed by way of Affidavit of Ram Rattan Inspector SHO PS Industrial Area, Phase-1, Chandigarh, no further direction is required to be issued in the instant case.

The instant petition is dismissed as having become rendered infructuous.
