The instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate order or directions directing the respondent No.1 to 3 to file the final report in case bearing FIR No.066 dated 06.06.2019 under Sections 365, 343 and Section 34 (420 and 120-B added later on) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, same was the condition on the last date of hearing.

Status report by way of affidavit of Manjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed. The relevant extract of the same is reproduced as under:-

15. That after completion of investigation challan against accused Mandip Kaur, Shail Singh, Chhinderpal Singh, Kamaljit Singh, Baljit Singh, Surjit Singh, Jagdev Singh

Saroop Singh, Lakhvir Singh, Jagroop Singh, Chamkaur Singh, Inderjit Sharma and Baldev, was presented before the Ld. Court on 27.08.2020, whereas accused Shamsher Singh was already died during investigation of the case.

In view of the averments contained in the status report and the fact that final report has already been filed, no further grievance survives in the instant petition.

Dismissed at this stage.
