Counsel for the respondents submits that on account of last mercy chance to appear in the Departmental Accounts Examination for SO-Part-I, the appellant-petitioner has qualified the same and, thus, he has been taken back in service.

Keeping in view the above fact, since the challenge in the writ petition was to the order dated 16.10.2019 (Annexure P-18), whereby services of the appellant-petitioner were dispensed with on account of non passing of the Departmental Accounts Examination, the litigation in the instant appeal has been rendered infructuous on account of the fact that appellant-petitioner has qualified for same.

In view of the above facts, the appeal, as such, directed against the order of learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition on 24.10.2019, has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
