Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that as per the transfer policy, station was to be allotted on the basis of the merit obtained by a candidate and whosoever was more meritorious qua a particular station was allotted the said station. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner opted for a station in Rewari district but the said station was allotted to one Vinod Kumari, who had already retired upto the date of passing of the transfer order and the petitioner on the basis of seniority and option submitted by her, was not allotted the said station. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the action of the respondents in not allotting a particular station in district Rewari to the petitioner by allotting the same to a retired employee, is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner against the order of transfer passed by the respondents, the petitioner can approach the respondents raising her grievance within a period of two weeks from today and an appropriate order on the prayer of the petitioner will be passed by the respondents within a period of 04 weeks from the receipt of the same and in case the petitioner is found entitled for allotment of Station Rewari as per her merit and option, an appropriate order will be passed by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation raising her grievance before the respondents.

Ordered accordingly.
