The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking quashing/setting aside the order dated 29.8.2017 vide which the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender.

On 7.12.2019, this Court while staying the operation of the impugned order dated 29.8.2017 had also observed that the impugned order shall remain stayed only on the condition that the petitioner surrender before the trial Court in the criminal case pending against him within a period of 10 days.

The petitioner has moved an application by which he has also attached the order dated 11.12.2019 (Annexure P-2) whereby he has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in the present case.

Consequently, the present petition is, hereby, dismissed.
