In compliance with the order passed by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit of the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Barnala dated 09.05.2022 has been filed in Court, according to which, proceedings for eviction had been initiated against respondent No. 6-Jotpuri Tap Asthan Sant Uttar Dev Ji Maharaj, Village Mangewal, Tehsil and District Barnala, which are pending before the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Barnala. It has also been brought to the notice of the Court that a Civil Suit has been preferred by the said respondent, in which application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC was dismissed by the trial

Court and on an appeal preferred by the said *dera*, an interim order has been passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Barnala. It has further been stated that in the proceedings, which have been initiated under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, the final order would be passed within a period of four weeks from the next date of hearing i.e. 11.05.2022.

In the light of the above, we dispose of the present writ petition without commenting upon the merits of the case. Respondents shall be bound by the statement of the learned counsel for the State who had made that on instructions from Sh. Roop Singh, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Barnala.
