The present criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and further to decide the representation dated 21.12.2022 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 21.12.2022 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
