The case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the officials respondents to grant the parole to the petitioner for 3 months on medical ground or extend the parole for another 3 months from 56 days vide Release Certificate dated 27.09.2019 issued by Superintendent of Central Jail, Patiala (Annexure P-1).
