[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.01.2019, in CWP-40323-2018 in case titled as 'Sangat Singh versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-40323-2018 was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 08.10.2018 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits on decision of the legal notice, to release the same to him within three months thereafter, while restricting the payment to arrears of 38 months prior to the filing of the writ petition.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that needful in terms of order (Annexure P-1) has been done and payment as per entitlement made to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
