The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Short reply by way of affidavit of Balkar Singh Bhullar, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, dated 24.02.2022, has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel at the outset has submitted that as per

para No.4 of the said reply, it has been stated that the case of the present petitioner for being released on parole was again initiated by respondent No.3 and the competent authority had again rejected the same, vide order dated 13.07.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition by challenging the order dated 13.07.2021. It is further prayed that the petitioner be allowed to raise the pleas which have been raised in this petition at the appropriate stage, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition by challenging the order dated 13.07.2021. The pleas raised in the present petition would be available to the petitioner in case, he chooses to file a fresh petition challenging the order dated 13.07.2021, in accordance with law.
