The petitioner is seeking transfer of the case bearing FIR No.0049 dated 22.05.2019 under Sections 498-A/406 and 323 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Gurdaspur from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur to competent jurisdiction at SAS Nagar (Mohali) or to any other independent place.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, submits that the FIR in question has been quashed by this Court in terms of the order dated 09.10.2020 passed in CRM-M-28033-2020. Consequently, the case in the trial Court has finally disposed of on 17.11.2020 and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categorical assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
