[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.05.2019, in CWP No.13412 of 2019 in case titled as 'Krishan Singh *versus* Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited, Ludhiana and others'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment as per entitlement having been released to the petitioner in terms of claim made in demand notice dated 23.03.2019, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
