MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking blanket bail as they apprehend that on account of political vendetta they could be implicated in false criminal cases. A prayer has also been made to direct respondents No.3 to 6 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.7 to 11.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that admittedly no FIR as on date stands registered against them, however, there is every likelihood that they could be involved in false cases on account of their close proximity to some leaders of the opposition party.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Concededly neither any complaint has been made against the petitioners nor any criminal case registered against them. Merely on the basis of their vague apprehension that they could be falsely implicated in a criminal case in the future, on account of their

close proximity with some leaders of the opposition party, the petitioners cannot be extended the concession of pre-arrest/blanket bail.

Dismissed.
