Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is involved in some more FIRs, in which he has already been granted the concession of bail either by this Court or by the trial Court. It is further submitted that in pursuance to an order dated 22.12.2022, the petitioner was granted bail in FIR No.8 dated 28.01.2022, FIR No.56 dated 30.05.2022, FIR No.100 dated 10.10.2022 and FIR No.144 dated 21.10.2022. It is further submitted that when son of the petitioner has gone to execute the bail/surety bonds on 22.12.2022, it was found that the police is present and the petitioner is likely to be involved in some other case and in that eventuality, the petitioner will not come out. It is also submitted that the petitioner be issued 07 days advance notice in case any fresh FIR is to be registered against him. It is also submitted that till 23.12.2022, the petitioner is not involved in any other case except the cases mentioned in the present petition.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and could not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of. The respondents will issue advance notice for 07 days in case the petitioner is required to be arrested in any similar FIR.
