[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2019 in CWP No.24736 of 2019 in case titled as Kanwaljit Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.24736 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider representation dated 18.06.2019 filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case and at the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that representation dated 18.06.2019 filed by the petitioner has been decided and possession of the plot allotted to the petitioner handed over to him and that in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
