[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.07.2019, in CWP No.20658 of 2019 in case titled as '**Paramjit Singh versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.20658 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the Director, Local Government, Punjab, to consider and decide representation dated 11.01.2017 in view of report dated 21.02.2017, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Although, notice has not been issued in the instant case, yet, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to time taken by the learned State Counsel to obtain instructions, respondent No.1 passed

speaking order dated 25.02.2020, addressing the grievance of the petitioner and that in view of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 25.02.2020, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
