ALOK JAIN, J. :

The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the parents of the petitioners were contacted and have recorded their statements. They have no objection to the relationship of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also submitted on the same lines and he submits that at this stage, there is no imminent threat to the petitioners. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.4 (Tayaji of the girl) was giving threat to the petitioners but now he has also accepted the relationship.

Learned State counsel has no instructions qua respondent No.4, who, according to him lives out of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
