The petitioner herein is Judgment Debtor No.76 in an execution petition. He was proceeded ex parte in the execution petition. His application for setting aside the ex parte proceedings has been dismissed. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he is not being permitted to join the proceedings.

Once, the proceedings are pending, the petitioner can join the proceedings at any stage. The ex parte proceedings does not debar the party from joining the proceedings. The setting aside of the ex parte proceedings is required if the applicant want that he should be relegated to the same position on which he was proceeded ex parte. Once, the petitioner is only interested in joining the proceedings, the Court will permit him to join.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
