The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to take action against the respondent No.6, who is practicing quackery as an Eye Specialist without having any requisite qualification and against the guidelines provided by the Hon'ble Court and Act passed by legislature.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Parneet Kaur, Drug Inspector, Malerkotla, submits that the respondent No.6 has already died on 03.08.2022.

In view of the statement made above by the learned State Counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage. He, however, seeks liberty to file appropriate petition for raising such issue in future if need be.
