Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.63 dated 11.10.2019 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Women, Bathinda.

By virtue of the order dated 12.3.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that investigation is complete and challan is also presented.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.3.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
