In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the step up of their pay equal to their junior namely, Jai Parkash s/o Kundan Lal who was Lecturer in Maths and is junior to all the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, notice of motion has already been issued but the respondents have not filed any reply and the petitioners will be satisfied in case, their claim as raised in the present petition is considered and decided within a time frame.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions from the respondents that the claim of the petitioners as raised in the present petition will be considered by the respondents and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned State counsel further submits that in case, the claim of the petitioners is found meritorious, the relief will be granted to the petitioners including the consequential relief, which will be released within a further period of four weeks.
