Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.606, dated 18.9.2019, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

By virtue of the order dated 13.12.2019, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the parties have already settled the dispute amicably and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is also filed, in which first motion statements have also been recorded and now the case is fixed for recording of second motion statements on 23.2.2023 and half of the agreed amount has been paid i.e. Rs.2,70,000/-. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 13.12.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
