The present petition is for quashing Rules 4, 6, 8, 11 and Schedule I of the Haryana Outstanding Sports persons (Recruitment and Conditions of Service Rules, 2018). A further prayer has been made to fill up posts of the HCS (Executive Branch) only through the Haryana Public Service

Commission after following the procedure and qualifications envisaged in the Haryana Civil Service (Executive Branch) Rules 2008.

A Co-ordinate Bench on 20.02.2019 had made certain observations whereby the State Government was given an opportunity to rethink and revisit the rules in question for streamlining the issue.

Mr. Talwar, himself has placed on record the new Rules called the Haryana Outstanding Sportspersons (Group A, B and C) Service Rules, 2021 notified on 26.02.2021. He further submits that as per Rules of 2021, the earlier Rules of 2018 has been repealed.

Counsel for the State concedes that no appointment to HCS and HPS has been made under the 2018 Rules.

The said statement satisfies the counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
