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**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the respective parties submit that the question of law raised in the present petition has already been answered by this Court in **CWP No.18212 of 2021** titled **Vinod Kumar Rajput versus Punjab National Bank and others** and the present petition be also disposed of in the same terms.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in **Vinod Kumar Rajput's case (supra)**, the life certificate was not submitted whereas in the present case, life certificate has already been submitted by the petitioner and now, the respondents are only required to pass the order releasing the arrears of the pension.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of in the same terms as in CWP No.18212 of 2021 and in case, the life certificate has already been submitted by the petitioner, let the respondents pass appropriate order for the release of arrears of pension to the petitioner within a period of two months from the receipt of this order.
