Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.92, dated 07.11.2019, under Sections 34, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Sonapat.
