Petitioner has filed this revision petition under Article 227 Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 19.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by District Judge, Sangrur, whereby his transfer application bearing No.66 of 16.09.2019 for transfer of suit titled '*Kirpal Singh Vs. Mohan Singh etc.*' pending before the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Malerkotla to any other sub-division of District Sangrur was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that only on one occasion, defendant No.1/petitioner was represented by the counsel, but subsequently, his counsel refused to represent him, as the plaintiff is a practising advocate. He submits that the application filed for transfer of the civil suit has been wrongly dismissed by the District Judge, Sangrur vide impugned order dated 19.10.2019 (Annexure P-1).

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioner never sought transfer of the civil suit outside the District Courts, Sangrur to some other Court of competent jurisdiction.

Further, a perusal of the application shows that it is based upon a doubt that

the decision in the civil suit may not be fair and just.

Considering the above background, particularly the contents of the application, this Court finds that the prayer for transfer of suit is baseless and misconceived. The impugned order does not suffer from any illegality or impropriety.

No ground is made out for interference.

Dismissed.
