[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P-1 dated 21.04.1998 passed by this Court in RFA No.225 of 1981, supplementary Award (Annexure P-2) dated 18.01.1991 passed by respondent No.1 and the same having attained finality vide order (Annexure P-5) dated 26.08.2013 in CWP No.11392 of 1991.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners has not been able to show the maintainability of the instant petition in terms of Section 20 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[3] Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out proceeding in accordance with law to seek execution of orders, Annexures P-1 & P-2.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
