The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to re-instate/revive the electric Tubewell connection in the name of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents No.1 to 5 has produced today in Court the photocopy of an affidavit dated 03.08.2021 sworn by the petitioner. The paragraph No.2 of the same reads thus:

“2. That presently deponent filed one C.W.P. no.29760 of 2018 in honorable High Court of Punjab and Haryana Chandigarh against P.S.P. Corp. Patiala through its chairman, for issuance of direction for release/reinstate of Tubewell connection Under Chairman Quota. Deponent undertakes to withdraw the said petition against P.S.P.C.L & others on or before date fixed.”

The photocopy of the said affidavit is taken on record as Annexure-X. Registry is directed to tag the same with the paper book at appropriate place and page mark the same.

Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In view the contents of the aforesaid affidavit coupled with the absence of the petitioner and his counsel as well, this Court has no option but to assume that the petitioner does not intend to pursue the instant petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
