HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners with a prayer that the petitioners were actually appointed in the respondent-Department starting from the year 1992 to 1999 and their respective services were regularised by the respondent-Department starting from the year 1995 till 2003, and they were entitled for the said regularization of their services upon completion of 240 days of their respective services keeping in view the instructions issued by the respondents, coupled with the settled principle of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondents are liable to be directed to regularize the services of the petitioners upon completion of 240 days of their respective services.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the

same grievance has also been raised by the petitioners before respondents No.2 and 3 by serving legal notice dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice dated 15.07.2019, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioners for deciding the legal notice dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioners in the present case as well as in the legal notice dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-7), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-7), filed by the petitioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
