This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondents to wave off the condition of passing of preliminary examination thereby allowing the petitioner to appear in main SAS examination being held on 23.10.2018 by setting aside the order dated 14.09.2018 vide which request of the petitioner has been declined; along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for the respondents-UOI has pointed out that the petitioner is an employee of Union of India. The petitioner is

required to approach Central Administrative Tribunal. However, the petitioner has wrongly approached this court directly.

In view of the above, this court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate forum for the same cause of action, in accordance with law.

All the pending applications also stand dismissed accordingly.
