JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the entire selection process made under advertisement dated 23.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) as the merit list has not been prepared correctly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that there were 12 posts, which were kept reserved under the sports category for female candidates and the petitioner, who had obtained 37 marks was not considered despite the fact that she had sufficient merit and had participated in several championships.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 05.12.2018, learned State counsel would submit that the petitioner's case was re-considered and by order dated 11.07.2020, she has been given appointment with effect

from 11.07.2020 with a Constabulary No.75/290 in Armed Police. He would submit that in view of the said appointment having been made, the instant petition has rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant writ petition with liberty to approach the department for her claim regarding seniority etc.

Dismissed as not pressed, with the liberty aforesaid.
