This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent-Bank to allow the petitioner to submit his documents as his roll number i.e. 1321003415 has been shortlisted for the post of Office Attendant and to allow the petitioner to appear in LPT (Language Proficiency Test).

The counsel for the respondents has pointed out that the petitioner has obtained lesser marks than the last selected candidate in his category. Therefore, the petitioner does not come in the merit list.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
